

Visitor Parking

Visitors to the University's main campus have three parking options. They may park in pay lots, at meters, or purchase a day pass or temporary permit. Patients and visitors to University Hospital may park free in the Visitor/Patient Lot or take advantage of the free valet parking service the Hospital provides. A pay lot and meters are also available.

Pay Lots

There are four pay lots on main campus. They are located:

- between the University Bookstore and Marriott Library,
- adjacent to the Student Services Building,
- across the street from the Olpin Union, and
- in the Business Loop east of the Fine Arts Museum.

On upper campus there are two pay lots:

- one in the HCI Terrace and
- one in the lower level of the South Terrace.

Hours of Operation

All pay lots open approximately 7 a.m. Monday through Friday, but close at different times:

Bookstore/Marriott Library Lot	Approximately 12:30 a.m.
Student Services Lot	6:30 p.m.
Olpin Union Lot	Approximately 11:30 p.m.
Fine Arts Lot (Lot 12)	Approximately 10:00 p.m.
Health Sciences Lot (Lot 56 So. Terrace)	6:30 p.m.
Huntsman Cancer Institute	Approximately 10:00 p.m.

The Rate Schedule

The rate schedule for all lots is \$2.00 for the first hour and \$1.00 for each additional hour with a Maximum charge of \$10.00 per exit. After hours charges (entrance to a pay lot after 6:00 p.m.) \$2.00 for the first hour with a maximum fee of \$3.00. Union pay lot \$1.00 after 6:00 p.m.

Payment can be made using cash or credit card.

Parking Meters

Parking meters are located in most lots on campus. They allow parking from 36 minutes to 2 hours, depending on location. The time each meter allows is printed on the meter head just below the time window and immediately above the rate schedule. The LED readout displays the time purchased and will not add time when the limit is reached. Meters can take nickels, dimes, and quarters but will not accept foreign coins.

Load Zone Meters

In addition to regular parking meters, load zone meters are also available. Designed for use by visitors and delivery vehicles, they allow 20 minutes of free parking. An additional 10 minutes can be purchased for \$.25. These meters are not designed for all day use, even if using a "V" or "D". U of U Maintenance vehicles are prohibited from using load zone meters.

Expired Meters

Parking citations will be issued for expired meters. If you think a meter is malfunctioning, please contact Commuter Services at 581-3204, to report it.
