

Visiting Alaska during the 2006 AAPT Winter Meeting

There are many exciting activities to participate in when you visit Alaska during the 2006 AAPT Winter Meeting, Jan. 21-25. Below are just a couple of descriptions:

Mt. McKinley Flightsee – Take a break and flightsee Mt. McKinley, this spectacular flight departs Anchorage and takes you within 6 miles of Mt. McKinley's 20,320 foot summit. Fly over foothills and spot wildlife while on your way to the Alaska Range. You will get to view Ruth Glacier, the Great Gorge and the massive south face of McKinley.

Winter Cruise Tour – Take a 3-Hour cruise on Resurrection Bay! The cruise departs from Seward, Alaska, which is 2½-hour drive South of Anchorage. This unique cruise is designed for people to view both the awesome migratory and the year round resident whales of the Resurrection Bay area. Often the Orca whales and the Dall porpoise come up and play off the wake of the boat so don't miss this wonderful photo opportunity. Even if the whales prove elusive, you still have many opportunities to view various marine wildlife including sea otters, eagles and sea lions.

Alyeska Prince Resort – Before or after your convention, take time out in your hectic life and enjoy a relaxing retreat in the peaceful little resort town of Girdwood. The Alyeska Prince Resort is Alaska's only 4-Star Hotel. You can choose from several package options or you may drive down for a day of exceptional skiing finished off with dinner at one of the fine restaurants the Resort or Girdwood has to offer!

Winter Sled Dog Tour – Girdwood is the setting for an exciting adventure, where you will encounter an unforgettable SLED DOG EXPERIENCE at a local musher's winter training site. Step aboard a custom sled where your tour guides provide lively narration of trail lore and stories of the historic Iditarod Trail. Afterwards pose for photos in a genuine dog sled with the dogs!

Snowmachine Tour – Girdwood is the starting point for your day of snowmachine adventure. After orientation, your guide will lead you on a relaxing trail ride. Enjoy traveling on a snowmobile across open snow filled meadows, and through a forested trail. You'll stop to look for wildlife and to soak in the grandeur of this beautiful country. Majestic mountains and hanging glaciers offer an unlimited photographic opportunity; so don't forget your camera!

Horseback Riding – Cooper Landing, nestled on the banks of the Kenai River, is the starting point for this horseback riding adventure. Upon arriving, you will saddle up for a fun filled horseback ride through the backcountry of Cooper Landing. This adventurous trail takes in the base of Mt. Langille, famous for its abundance of sheep. Many say this ride is the best memory of their Alaskan vacation.
