

### 2009 PhysicsBowl Results

Dear Physics Teacher,

Thank you for having your students participate in this year's AAPT PHYSICSBOWL contest.

This year there were almost 4500 students participating from approximately 225 schools across the United States and Canada as well as a school in China. Enclosed are lists of the first and second place schools in each division and the first and second place students in each division by region. Several placings were determined by tie-breakers. For students, the answers were compared from the end of the test forward until the tie was resolved. For schools, the tie was broken by comparing the highest scoring students for each team. Unfortunately, we received many answer sheets which did not properly fill in the required information... which resulted in the student's score being made a zero in most cases. This is an unfortunate necessity because of the amount of data that must be analyzed and the large amount of time it takes to analyze.

This year, the following prizes are awarded:

- To schools:
  - o \$100 Frey gift certificate awarded to the schools placing first in each region and division from Frey Scientific.
  - o \$50 Vernier gift certificate awarded to the schools placing first *and second* in each region and division from Vernier Software & Technology
  - \$25 AAPT Store gift certificate awarded to the schools placing first and second in each region and division.
- To students:
  - o The book "Chasing the Rainbow" awarded to the students placing first and second in each region and division from Robert Greenler.
  - o TI-30 XS MultiView Scientific Calculator awarded to the students and schools placing first and second in each region and division from Texas Instruments.
  - o T-shirts awarded to the five top students in the top scoring school in each region from AAPT.





### Statistics for exam

Average Score for Division I = 15.7 with a standard deviation of 5.7 Average Score for Division II = 15.3 with a standard deviation of 5.5





\*\*\*\* The production of a challenging contest of only 40 questions so that scores are not concentrated at the upper end of the scale is an enormous task. This exam was of comparable difficulty to previous exams and had a higher average than last year's contest.
