<b>Poster</b>	<p>Read the poster ahead of time and think of questions if you are able. You can find posters in the schedule or through the posters section found on the left side of underline.io</p>	<p>Come to the poster during the time it is listed during the conference. Presenters will be at their posters answering questions in the chat. During poster session times you are encouraged to bounce around multiple posters, just as you would during an in-person poster session</p>
<b>Talks</b>	<p>Find the talks you want to see using the schedule. When you find a talk, click on the tile and watch the video ahead of session time listed in the program. You can also read the slides and abstracts. Post questions in the chat to the side for presenters to see, or save them for the live session.</p>	<p>At the time listed in the conference, go the session page for the session you want to participate in. You will see the tiles for all the talks plus a "Q&amp;A" tile. This is the live events. Click on the Q&amp;A tile, and if you are one of the first 50 people in the session you will be able to connect to a live video chat with the presenters and a moderator, where you can ask questions about the presentation you watched previously. You are also able to ask questions in the chat. If you are unable to join the video rooms because they are full, you will still be able to watch them live, and ask questions in the chat. <b>Talks</b>	Find your talk using the schedule and see what questions have been posted on it. Answer them in the chat, and be prepared to discuss them in your live sessions.	At the time listed in the conference, go to the session page for your talk. You will see the tiles for all the talks plus a "Q&A" tile. These are live events. Click on the Q&A tile, and you will be able to connect to a live video chat. With help from a moderator, you will answer questions live both from participants in the video chat and from the live text chat feature on the right.
