SWE's top award goes to Mildred Dresselhaus

The Society of Women Engineers has conferred its most prestigious honor, the 1977 Achievement Award, on **Dr. Mildred Dresselhaus**, one of the world's leading experts in electrical and optical phenomena of materials.

The award was presented to Dr. Dresselhaus at the SWE National Convention last June in Cincinnati.

It is given annually to the woman (not necessarily a member of the Society) whom the SWE Awards Committee finds has made a significant contribution to engineering through engineering practice, research, education or administration.

Dr. Dresselhaus, a Boston SWE Section Senior Member, is professor of electrical engineering and Abby Rockefeller Mauze Professor at Massachusetts Institute of Tech-


