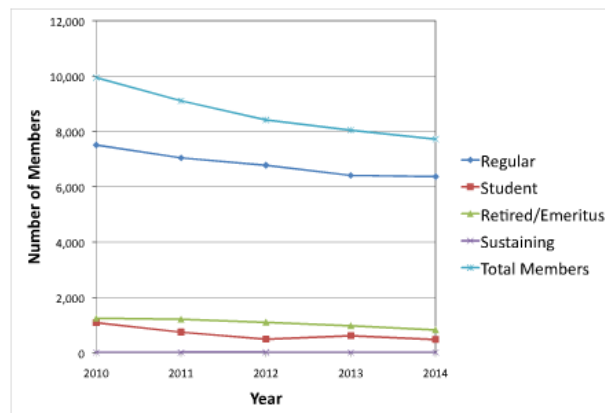

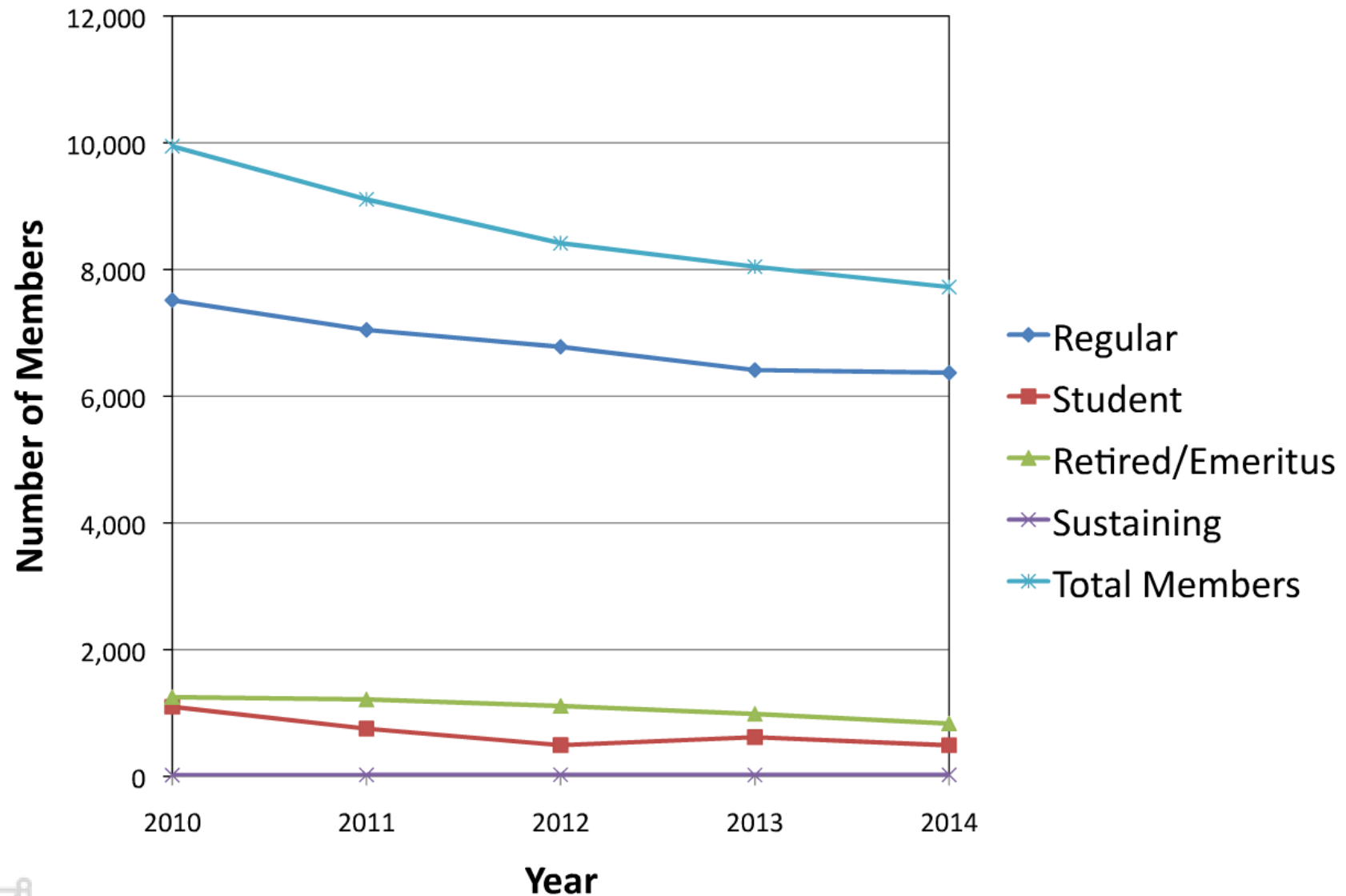
All Member Types



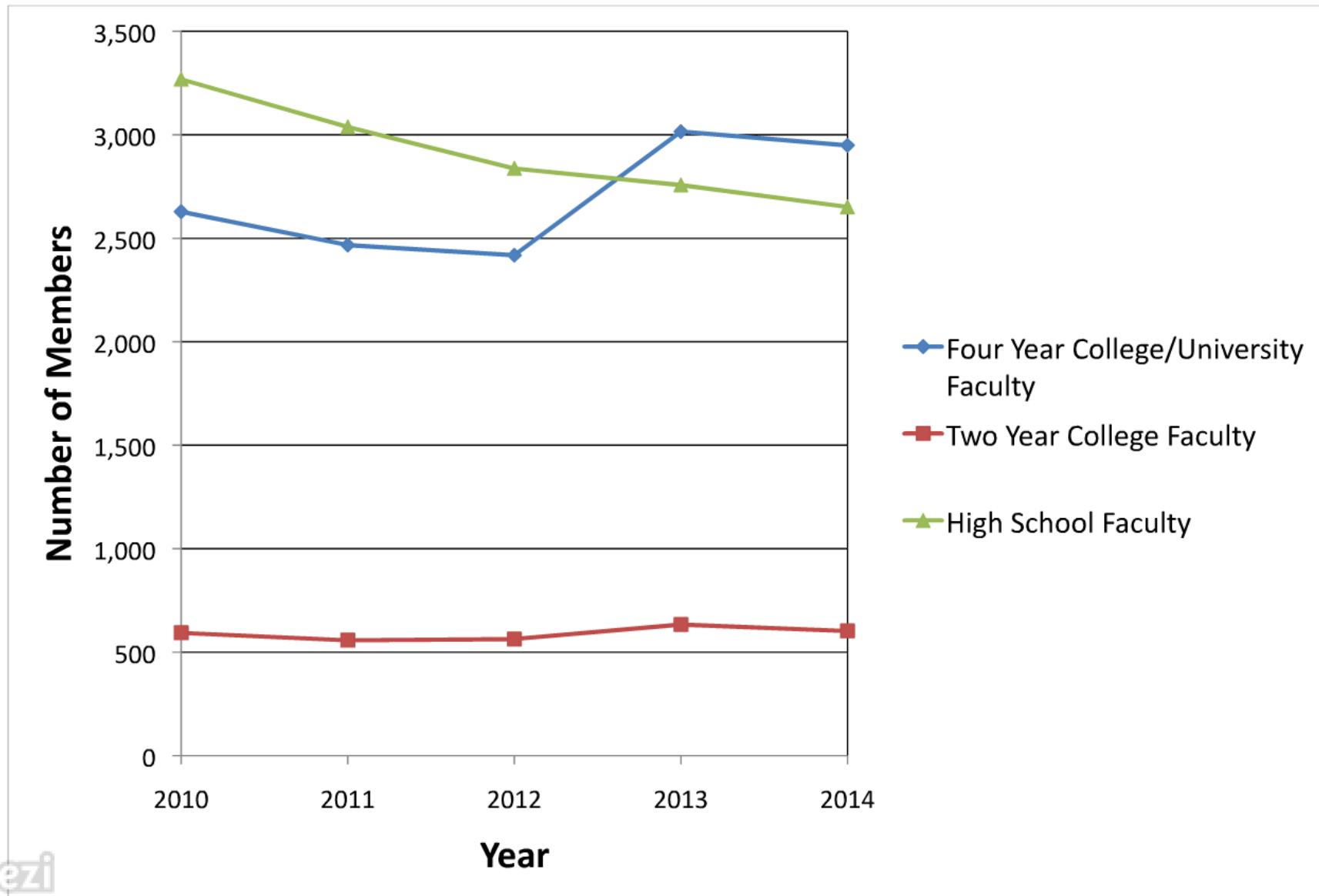
Regular Member Breakdown

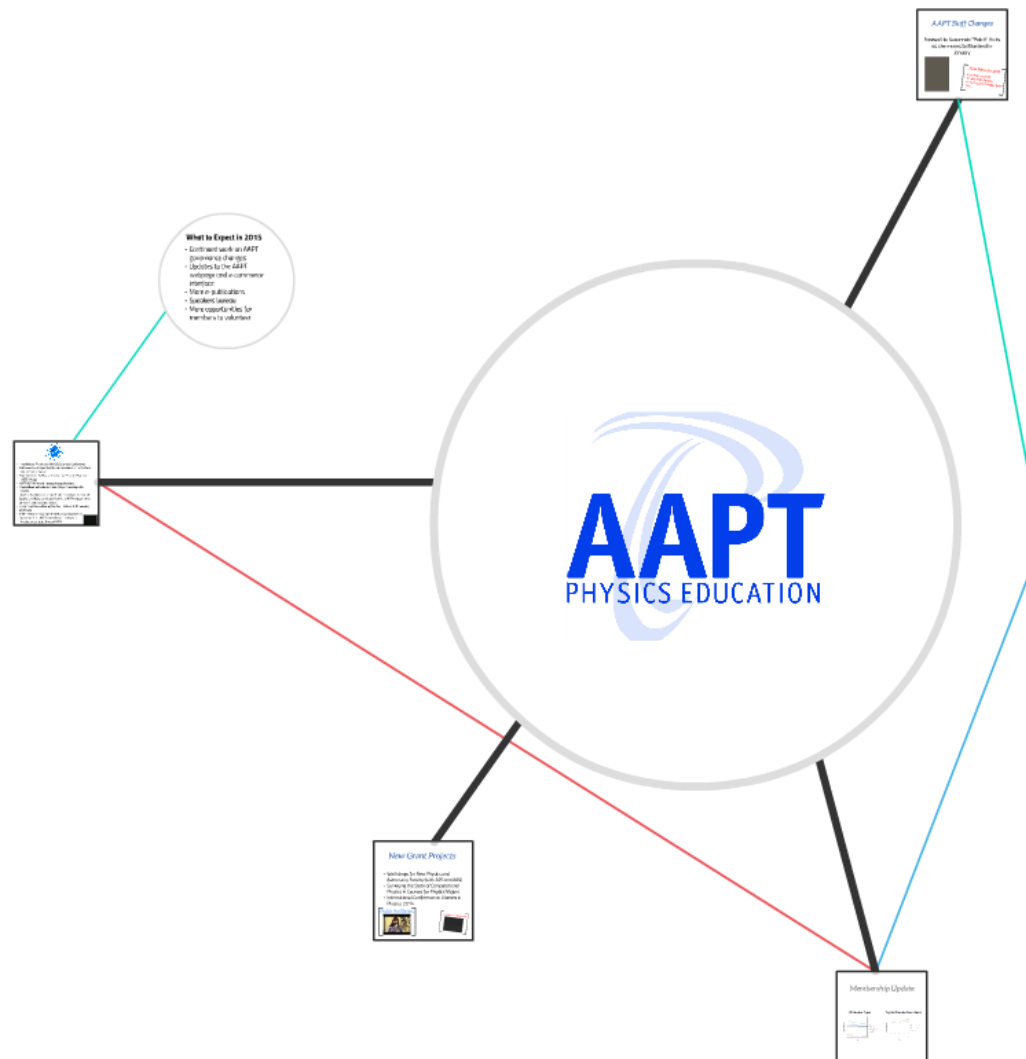
